Eytan is an experienced entrepreneur, CEO, Executive Director and investor who has spent his career successfully founding and growing disruptive technology-based companies. Eytan has experience in IPOs, management of public companies, M&A's and capital raising from the public, institutional investors, venture capital funds, private equity funds, corporates, and angels.

Founded AqWise in 2000 and lead from the idea stage to global success in its space. AqWise has today over 450 installations in 40 countries.

Eytan was part of the founding team and a Venture Partner in ICV (Israel Cleantech Ventures), Israel's leading cleantech venture capital fund, focused on backing Israel's emerging clean technology companies.

Founded Emefcy in 2008, and as managing director and CEO, took it public at the ASX in December 2015 (ASX: EMC). With a market cap reaching US\$0.25B, Emefcy acquired RWL Water and merged it with Emefcy in 2017 to form Fluence (ASX:FLC), a global leader in smart decentralized water and wastewater treatment solutions.

Eytan developed subsidiaries globally for Emefcy and AqWise, including the development of a production plant and sales offices in China and sales offices in the US and Latin America.

He was recognized by The Marker, a top Israeli business magazine, as one of the 100 Most Influential Individuals in Israel for his environmental achievements and was featured on the front page of Forbes Israel in a cover story about Israel's most successful water ventures.

He was also Founder and Chairman of the Israeli Wastewater Treatment Forum and Co-Founder Israel Water Association.

In 2017, Eytan founded 'Levy Ventures', which invests in early-stage water-tech companies and provides them with business tools to become fast-growing, global players.

Eytan is the Executive Chairman of Tevet Water Technologies Ltd, which focuses on advanced physicochemical treatment of dairy farms effluent.

Eytan holds a B. Sc. In Chemical Engineering (cum laude) from the Technion in Israel, and an MBA from Bar-Ilan University. He has completed several entrepreneurship programs with a GE Corporate University, focused on leadership development and management methods.
