Mr. Gillespie, Jason, currently serves as Managing Director of Environmental Services for the Maryland Environmental Service, an independent, self-supporting State Agency created to protect the State's air, land and water resources. This includes operation of 94 wastewater treatment facilities and 144 water treatment facilities.
